ACCESS TO MARINA

Access through the gates is controlled 24/7 and gained by downloading the ICT Protégé App. Instructions on how to do this are available in the Marina Office.

POWER

All vessels wishing to plug into power must have a current NZ Electrical Warrant of Fitness (EWOFF) displayed and to be sighted by marina office. A power lead can be run from the pedestal to a power board for use in the boat, but the leads must be in 12mth test and tagged. Power is charged on a user pays basis.

WATER

The water at the marina is drinkable bore water. Please do not waste water and ensure that taps and hoses are turned off after use. Fire hoses are only for use in the case of a fire.

TOILETS AND SHOWERS

There is a \$5 fee per person per shower for the use of the Yacht Club showers.

LAUNDRY

Situated in the tractor shed. Both the washing machine and dryer require multiple \$2.00 coins for machines.

FUEL

Diesel is only available for Yacht Club members or renters from the fuel berth at the club wharf. Back your vessel in against the western end of the club wharf (red painted area) as the hose is not very long. The marina dock Crew are able to assist with fuel dispensing during office hours, or club members can apply for a fuel card that gives access to the fuel at all hours. Any fuel spills must be reported to Marina office and serious spills addressed immediately.



LINES

Mooring lines are available on each berth.

BERTH FENDERS

Sandspit Marina has sourced a fender system that is compatible with our pontoons. To keep the uniform look of the marina, the society will only permit this system to be used. Orders for the fitted fenders can be placed at the Marina Office.

RUBBISH

The rubbish compound is beside the trailer boat ramp, with access by the ICT Protege app. Please separate your rubbish (cardboard and plastics etc) and use the recycling bins provided. All general rubbish must be bagged.

SEWAGE

The marina is a NO discharge area. There is a portable pump out facility available. For charges and use contact the Marina Manager.

ONBOARD OVERNIGHTING

Overnight stays are limited to 3 consecutive nights per week unless approved by the Marina Manager.

PARKING

A valid car parking permit for the Sandspit Yacht Club car park area must be displayed. Maximum car parking 3 nights. For longer term parking, please use the car park at 6 Brick Bay Rd.

Trailer parking in the SYC car park is limited to 1 night only. For any longer periods, please park your trailer at 6 Brick Bay Rd.

BIOSECURITY THREAT

Sandspit Marina has the opportunity to prevent unwanted notifiable pests like fanworm entering our marina. The marina will follow the Northland 6 - 1 policy whereby vessels entering the marina from other areas must have had their boats washed down in the last month or anti-fouled in the last 6 months. All marina owners berthing their boats for the first time, must ensure their hulls are free of unwanted organisms. The best way to avoid the nasties is to keep your hull clean. Not only does it prevent the spread of pests, it also makes your boat go faster!

INSURANCE

All vessels staying in the marina must have Third Party insurance (minimum of \$5 million for vessels 16m and below, \$10m for vessels above 16m required) and provide a copy of the current insurance schedule to the Marina Office. It pays to ask your insurance company to automatically send a copy to the Marina Office at each renewal.

CONTRACTORS

All contractors are required to be approved by the Marina Office and sign in/out at the Marina Office before entering the marina and on departure.



HOUSEKEEPING RULES

- No cycling, scooters, skateboards or personal electric vehicles on the marina (except for authorised mobility scooters)
- No fishing, swimming, or diving on the marina
- No screwing or bolting of apparatus is permitted on to the pontoons without the permission of the Marina Manager.
- All boats must fit within the dimensions of the berth
- Fire hoses are only for use in the case of a fire.
- Marina trolleys to be returned to top of the pontoon ramp after use.
- The pumping of toilets, bilge pumps, waste water or chemicals and the cleaning/gutting of fish into the marina environment is NOT permitted.
- No welding, grinding, sanding, water blasting, hotwork or spray painting is allowed within the marina.
- Dogs must be under control at all times. Please clean up after your pet.
- Halyards to be restrained to prevent slapping.
- All boats with stern drives or outboards must berth bow in only to avoid puncturing the pontoons.
- You must ensure you are not causing any damage to the pontoons while berthing or while moored.
- Lines must be fit for purpose and left tidy on fingers.
- All berth users must comply with the Marina Code of Conduct and Marina Rules (available on our website or on request).
